Line Officer and Chief Officer Accumulative Requirements	Date Revised: March 2017

Listed are the SOG MINIMUM requirements for line and chief officers in Owego Fire Department. All officers (Lieutenant, Captain, 874, 873, 872, 871) must be current for 8 hours of OSHA as described in our SOGs. The eight hours of OSHA can be completed through OFD training and or a combination of internet NFPA compliant OSHA courses. (Recommended source is McKinley E-Learning – ESIP)

•Note: in keeping with the ICS Incident Command regulation an officer may not hold more than one Line Officer Position at any given time and/or an EMS position.

All courses below include those taught at the National Fire Academy or NYS Fire Academy or by county NYS approved instructors. ICS/ NIMS offered by FEMA or equivalent. Certificates or NYS issued transcript or equivalent must be possessed.

1. Lieutenant -2 years in Owego Fire Department
  - a. Fire fighter I or Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations (BEFO)
  - b. NIMS 100
  - c. Certified on company apparatus
2. Captain -3 years in Owego Fire Department with 1 year as Lieutenant
  - a. Building Construction, Combustible
  - b. NIMS 200
3. Deputy Chief -Administration -874 -4 years in Owego Fire Department with:
  - a. ICS 100, 200, 300 and NIMS 700 and 800 300
  - b. Knowledge of Federal and NYS grant process
  - c. knowledge of the Village of Owego Procurement Policy
4. Assistant Chief - 873 –4 years in Owego Fire Department with 1 year at line officer level
  - a. Fire Officer 1
5. Assistant Chief - 872 –5 years in Owego Fire Department with 1 year at line officer level
  - a. Fire Officer 1
  - b. NIMS 300 (fire service)
6. Chief - 871 -5 years in Owego Fire Department with 1 year at line officer level
  - a. Fire Officer 1
  - b. NIMS 300 (fire service)
