RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes an agreement with the Town of Windsor, 124 Main Street, Windsor, New York 13865 for Broome County Security to provide security services at Windsor Town Court for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021, with the option for three one-year renewals, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in consideration of said services, the County shall receive revenue at the rate of \$39.71 per hour, total amount not to exceed \$6,552.15, for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, and at the rate of \$39,71 per hour plus a CPI increase for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that for each mutually agreed upon renewal term thereafter the County shall receive revenue at an amount based on the previous year's hourly rate plus a CPI increase, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revenue hereinabove authorized shall be credited to budget line 22000203.5000230, and he it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law as may be necessary to implement the Intent and purpose of this Resolution.
