## 2019 Budget

A proposed 2019 Sewer Budget of \$289,186 was presented to the Town Board on August 8, 2018. There is no increase in the 2019 Budget from the 2018 Budget. The cost per EDU will remain the same. The tentative budget will be reviewed and the preliminary budget prepared at the October 3, 2018 Town Board meeting. This meeting will be held at the West Windsor Fire Station at 7:00 pm.

### Notice of Public Hearing for 2019 Sewer Budget

A Public Hearing will be held regarding the adoption of the 2019 sewer billing rates for municipal sewer users in the Town of Windsor. This hearing will be at the Town Board meeting on November 7, 2018, 7:00 pm, Town of Windsor Town Hall, 124 Main Street, Windsor, NY 13865.

The proposed billing rates are:

2019 Quarterly Fee (Occupied)	\$218.00 Per EDU
2019 Quarterly Fee (Vacant)	138.30 Per EDU
2019 Quarterly Fee (Government/School)	212.64 Per EDU

Based on:

Occupied EDUs	278
Vacant EDUs	15
Government/School EDUs	31

The Guide for Unit Assessment is on the reverse side.

The billing becomes effective November 1, 2018 and will be billed starting the first billing cycle in 2019, March 2019.

Residential – Single Family	1.0 unit for each single family dwelling
Residential – Multiple Dwelling	Same as single family residence plus 1.0 unit for each family unit over one
Combined Residential & Commercial	Same as residential plus additional units based on the specific type of commercial use utilized
Vacant Parcel	1.0 unit for each vacant parcel
Retail Store	5.0 units
Service Station	5.0 units
Service Station/Convenience Store	7.0 units
Fast Food Restaurant	8.0 units plus 1.0 unit for 24 hours
School	0.1 units per pupil and/or staff member
Church	Same as single family residence
Church with Church Hall	2.0 units
Parsonage	Same as single family residence
Fire Station	2.0 units
Fire Station with Fire Hall	3.0 units
