Help Get Phosphorous Count Down

To get the phosphorous count down, it takes the use of expensive chemicals. One of the biggest sources of phosphorous is powder detergent. You can help by changing from powder to liquid detergent (laundry, dishwashing) to get the phosphorous count down. Even better is to use phosphate free detergent. Please check the labels of detergent you use.

Payment of Sewer Fees

The December 1st bill must be paid no later than January 7th (post marks accepted) in order to avoid a penalty.

The 2019 budget was approved by the Town Board on November 14, 2018. Quarterly sewer rates for 2019 will remain the same as 2018.
